Geochemistry: Deep ground water in crystalline rocks

The hydrochemistry research group has a studentship available. The project is in the broad field of water-rock interaction and hydrogeochemistry of deep water in granites and gneisses of the continental crust. The investigation is also related to the hydrogeology of fractured hard rock aquifers and to geothermal energy utilization. The study will lead to a Ph.D. degree at the University of Freiburg.
